2022 Far Side of the Moon

Composition:

71% Mourvèdre, 24% Grenache, 5% Cinsault

Our Far Side of the Moon blend is a special commemorative wine celebrating the total solar eclipse that took place on April 8th, 2024. This blend is the “dark” side of our “Over the Moon Rosé”, meaning it is the same wine, varietally, but made as a red wine instead of a Rosé.

This wine has lovely notes of strawberries, red cherries, and cocoa. It’s a medium-bodied wine with medium-minus tannins while being fairly juicy on the palate. This was blended with chilling in mind, so feel free to serve with a slight chill for those hot Texas nights.

This is a food friendly wine that will pair well with vegetarian dishes, pork, chicken, or simply a relaxing evening under the stars.

Cellar Recommendation:

Drink now through 2029

# Wines Featured in September Wine Club



## 2022 Viognier Reserve

*100% Viognier*

This wine has lots of tropical and floral notes such as candied pineapple, guava, and kiwi, as well as golden delicious apple, pear, and hints of brioche. This medium-bodied wine has a smooth mouthfeel and finish.

Cellar Recommendation: Drink now through 2025

## 2023 Over the Moon Rosé

*61% Mourvèdre, 21% Grenache, 12% Sangiovese, 6% Montepulciano*

The nose is fruit forward and refreshing with notes of melon, strawberry, rose petal, and stone. This light to medium-bodied rosé is smooth and easy drinking on the palate with pleasant and balanced acidity.

Cellar Recommendation: Drink now through 2028

## 2020 Cuvée 1853

*49% Cinsault, 28% Alicante Bouschet, 15% Syrah, 8% Mourvèdre*

This wine has a lovely nose of dark chocolate, black cherries, allspice, and forest floor with hints of dried herbs. The palate is juicy with ripe fruit and chocolate covered cherries. This medium-bodied wine has low tannins and is easy drinking with or without food.

Cellar Recommendation: Drink now through 2028

## 2020 Texas High Plains Malbec

*77% Malbec, 23% Tempranillo*

The nose on the Malbec is rich with blackberry, plum, forest floor, tobacco, with hints of smoke and floral notes. The palate is medium to medium-plus in body and fruity with a velvety mouthfeel and cocoa on the finish.

Cellar Recommendation: Drink now through 2025

## 2020 Vintner's Reserve

*46% Tempranillo, 39% Mourvèdre, 8% Grenache, 7% Graciano*

This wine has bright fruit notes, with red cherries, black cherries, cedar, bramble, cracked black pepper, leather, and tobacco leaf. You'll find this wine is medium to medium-minus bodied on the palate with fine tannins to match and lovely fruit notes through the finish.

Cellar Recommendation: Drink now through 2028

## 2021 Vintner's Reserve

*27% Petite Sirah, 20% Mourvèdre, 13% Carignan, 13% Graciano, 13% Syrah, 7% Malbec, 7% Petit Verdot*

The Vintner's Reserve is an aromatic wine with ample notes of black cherry, leather and a hint of vanilla. On the palate it is a light to medium-bodied wine with red cherry and a hint of smoke. Overall, this wine is smooth and approachable.

Cellar Recommendation: Drink now through 2029

## 2018 Farmhouse Vineyards Petite Sirah

*100% Petite Sirah*

The bouquet on this wine is rich with notes of ripe blackberries, blueberries, violets, white pepper and bramble. On the palate, rich dark fruit dominates with a velvety mouthfeel and luscious tannins.

Cellar Recommendation: Drink now through 2032

## 2019 Farmhouse Vineyards Petite Sirah

*100% Petite Sirah*

The bouquet on this wine is rich with notes of ripe blackberries, blueberries, anise, violets, bramble and game. On the palate rich dark fruit and leather linger through this medium-bodied wine and finish with refined tannins.

Cellar Recommendation: Drink now through 2028
